## **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Stephen John Gill for renewal of a Manager's Certificate.

Stephen and his wife Kim are the directors and shareholders of No 31 Hanmer Limited. The company has been the licence holder for No. 31 Restaurant and Bar in Hanmer Springs, since July 2015.

Stephen's role at the restaurant is a mixture of chef and front of house. He explained that during summer months he is mainly in the kitchen, as there are more front of house staff available at that time. In the winter, the opposite is the case with more kitchen staff available, and Stephen then works the front of house including as the duty manager.

In their reports, the Police and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to renewal.

Under section 218 of the Act the Committee must not renew a manager's certificate unless the manager holds the prescribed qualification.

As the applicant has successfully completed the Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test, the committee is satisfied that the criteria as set out in s.224 of the Act has been met.

A renewal notice can be issued and will remain in force until 19 February 2022.
