DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waipara Cellars Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 121 Carters Road, Amberley, known as "Super Liquor Amberley".

A change to the conditions of the licence is as follows, there are to be no single sales of RTD's and mainstream beer except from damaged packaging.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence with a change to the existing terms and conditions relating to the single sale of RTD's and mainstream beer until the 13th day of May 2024, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
