DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Fancrest Estate Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence, endorsed under s.40 of the Act for the remote sales of alcohol only, in respect of premises situated at 696 Omihi Road, Omihi, known as "Fancrest Estate".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.
