DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Harris Estate Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 6 Anzac Street, Waipara, known as "Harris Estate," to be endorsed under s. 40 of the Act for the the remote sale of alcohol.

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 20 February 2024, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

We order the Licensing Inspector to complete a website compliance check within 10 days of this decision, to ensure the following requirements are complied with:

- The licence holder's name
- The licence number
- Expiry date
- A copy of the licence
- A second age declaration

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority, we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
