DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Koyama Wines Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 434 Omihi Road, Omihi, known as "Mountford Estate".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

The on-licence operation over the past year was discussed with the licensee, Takahiro Koyama. He advised four or five pre-booked dinners, for approximately 20 people, were hosted since the on-licence was issued. These dinners are usually over by 11.00pm.

Events such as weddings, lunches and dinners are expected to be held under the licence although these will be infrequent and pre-booked for small groups.

Takahiro was issued a manager's certificate in November 2017 and is the sole duty manager for the winery. He advised he is present at all the events at the winery.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 09 February 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
