**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Amberley Hotel (2021) Limited for renewal of on and off licences in respect of premises situated at 84 Carters Road, Amberley, known as "Amberley Hotel".

The applicant sought the following changes to the on-licence:

- To license the current Crown and Pantry off-licence area as an on-licensed area. This is to enable small private events to be held in this area. The proposed licensed hours for this area are Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 10.00pm.
- Add an additional outdoor area at the rear of the premises to enable patrons to move through a licensed area between the bar smoking area and the Beer Garden.

No changes to the off-licence were sought.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to these applications.

The applicant is awaiting confirmation of Code of Compliance Certificate (CCC) under the Building Act 2004. Council's Building Team are currently processing this application and it is expected to be completed soon.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licences until 30 September 2025, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

The following condition is to be imposed on the on-licence 57/ON/509/2022, in accordance with s. 117 of the Act:

**Licensed Hours**

- Crown and Pantry Area: Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 10.00pm.

The Alcohol Regulatory Licensing Authority issued a Practice Direction (LIQ/ADM 1) which states, "Every time a licence is renewed, a replacement licence is to be issued with a new licence number. This is to ensure that the current expiry date and licence conditions are clear."

The replacement licences **will only** issue once confirmation of the Code of Compliance Certificate (CCC) is received from the Building Team.
