DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Michelle Beri and Lindsay Collins Partnership for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 18 Lyndon Street, Waiau, known as "Waiau Lodge Hotel".

The renewal application did not indicate any changes to the licence conditions, however, during the Licensing Inspector's inquiries, the applicant advised that they had been approached by a developer with a proposal to establish a camping ground on the land adjacent to the tavern. The proposal included changes to how the tavern operates. The application was placed on hold pending confirmation of these proposals.

The applicant has advised the Licensing Inspector that the proposal was not accepted and no changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 20 May 2026, that being the anniversary date of the licence and three years from the most recent date of expiry.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority, we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
