

# Notice of Decision



Decision No. 57/ON/521/2024

**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Himkhand Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 30E Conical Hill Road, Hanmer Springs, known as "Indian Springs".

The applicant initially initially sought to extend their licensed hours to 11.00am to 11.00pm. However the trading hours for the premises are subject to resource consent RC100053, being a restaurant with a seating capacity of 32 people and hours of operation between 11.30am to 2.00pm and 5.00pm to 9.30pm.

The applicant was advised that a change of hours would require a change to the resource consent. The applicant decided to remain within the hours permitted by the resource consent and planning certificate issued under s. 100(f) of the Act (Note: a 30-minute extension to the dinner shift is permitted)

The hours sought are:

Lunch shift: 11.30am – 2.00pm These hours are permitted under the resource consent.

Dinner shift: 4.30pm – 9.30pm These are the current hours under the on-licence.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Police were not opposed to the application, subject to satisfying the Inspector that they have sufficient qualified duty managers appointment to the premises. In paragraph 5.3 of the Licensing Inspector's Report, Ms Morrison wrote: *"On the basis of the information provided, the Inspector considers having three duty managers available will address the Police concerns. The Inspector is satisfied that three duty managers employed at the premises is adequate in relation to the hours the restaurant is open."*

The Licensing Inspector and Medical Officer of Health did not raise any matters in opposition to the application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence until 31 January 2027, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority, we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
