DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Waiau Collie Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 280 Chaffeys Road, Waiau and known as The Tongue Farm

The nature of the particular series of events for which the licence is sought is the annual Waiau Sheep Dog Trials with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 09 and Sunday 10 February 2019 from 11.30am to 8.30pm. The licensed area will be undesignated and consist of the same areas as the previous two years event being the cookhouse and veranda, the secretary's office and an outdoor area of approx. 25m x 20m which will be fenced off.

Leon McKay is the proposed manager for the event and although he does not hold a manager's certificate the Committee is satisfied that he will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol in accordance with the licence. The licensee is exempt from the requirements of appointing a manager under subpart 7 of the Act.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
