DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Dionysus Ventures Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 54 Seddon Street, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Show Grounds

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is Cheviot A&P Show with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 09 March 2019 from 10.30am to 5.00pm. The bar will cease serving at 4.30 pm to allow a 'drink-up' time. The licensed area is supervised and includes a $10m \times 10m$ gazebo with one closed side and defined by fencing.

Dionysus Ventures Limited, was previously named Teece Family Vineyards Limited, and trades as Mt Beautiful Wines. The applicant has held special licences for the off-site sale of wine at the Cheviot A&P show from 2015 to 2018 and a bar for on-site sales in 2017 and 2018.

The applicant initially sought both licences to trade from 9.00am until 8.00pm. These hours were substantially more than for previous years and would end later than the public bar at the show licensed by the Cheviot Rugby Club. The 2018 duty manager Erin Harrison advised that the licences were only required until 5.00pm.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

The licence may issue immediately.
