### **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Cheviot Rugby Football Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 57 Ward Road, Cheviot and known as Cheviot Rugby Club.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is the Community Barbecue with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 11 March 2023 from 3.00pm to 10.30pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the clubrooms main hall, supper room, outdoor veranda, ramp, concrete area in front of clubrooms.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The applicant and duty manager are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure the event does not adversely impact on the amenity and good order of the locality and community. Failure to appropriately manage the noise at events could jeopardise future applications, including limitations on the nature and hours the music is played.

The licence may issue immediately.
