**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Michelle Beri & Lindsay Collins Partnership for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 18 Lyndon Street, Waiau and known as Waiau Tavern.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Restore Rally with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Friday 13 October 2023 from 2.00pm to 1.00am the following day and Saturday 14 October 2023 from 11.00am to 1.00am the following day. The licensed area includes:

- **Supervised:** The two fenced paddocks behind the Waiau Lodge Hotel site.
- **Restricted:** The fenced off area immediately behind the Waiau Lodge Hotel site (contains the bar and food vendors).

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately.
