

# Notice of Decision

**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Brew Moon Brewing Company Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 6/50 Douglas Road, Amberley and known as Amberley Domain.

The event for which the licence is sought is Amberley A&P Show 2023 with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 28 October 2023 from 10.00am to 6.30pm.

This application is for the overarching licensed area, including the food demonstration area, the Brew Moon Bar and the President's Tent.

There will be two other alcohol vendors selling alcohol on-site:

1. Forthluck Limited, Special Licence No. 57/SP/2305/2023; and
2. Ataahua Wines Limited, Special Licence No. 57/SP/2311/2023.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes:

- The Hoof to Hotplate marquee;
- The President's Tent; and
- The adjacent outdoor roped off areas to the edge of the show ring.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately, and be subject to the following conditions:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Saturday 28 October 2023 from 10.00am to 6.30pm. Note:** alcohol sales must cease at 6.00pm to allow for a 30-minute drink up period.
- b) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the sale of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons is prohibited.
  - The licensed area is undesignated and includes:
    - The Hoof to Hotplate marquee,
    - The President's Tent, and
    - The adjacent outdoor roped off areas to the edge of the show ring.
- c) The following alcohol outlets have been licensed to sell alcohol at the event (**i.e., on-site sales of alcohol**):
  - Forthluck Limited.
  - Ataahua Wines Limited.
- d) The licensee shall take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed:
  - The licensee has appointed Oscar McCauley and Mathew Johns to manage the premises and will be present at all times while the licence is in force.
  - Signage must be displayed at all points of sale indicating the name of the manager on duty.
- e) Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business.
  - Free water will be available from the three stalls and the President's Tent.
- f) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is available for sale as follows:
  - Food options including burgers, hot chips, chicken tenders and other hot snacks will be available near the bar (outside of the licensed area).
  - PGG Wrightson's are expected to operate a barbecue in the licensed area.
- g) Low alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows:
  - Brew Moon Amberley Tea Pale Ale (2% abv.).
- h) Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows:
  - A range of soft drinks.
- i) The licensee must take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises:
  - Telephones will be available for patrons to make their own alternative transport arrangements.
