2025 Boating & Water Safety Experience for Families

The MainPower Amberley Pool Safe Boating Programme is a 50-minute session designed to provide practical, boating and water safety experience for children and adults – regardless of their confidence in the water.

The programme is New Zealand Coastguard initiative and includes in-water survival techniques, essential safety equipment (e.g. correct lifejacket selection and fitting), the importance of communications, and taking responsibility for personal safety.

Boating activities are taught at the pool in a fun, controlled, and safe environment.

Cost \$50 per family/group (maximum of six people per instructor, can be a mix of children, parents, grandparents, caregivers etc)

Sessions must be pre-booked and are available throughout Term One 2025:

- Saturday mornings in January 2025
- Sunday mornings January April 2025
- Weekdays after 4.30pm in January 2025
- Tuesday and Wednesday evenings from 7.15pm February April 2025.

Cancellations: Cancellations will be accepted with 72 hours notice and a postponement date will be arranged. No refunds will apply.
