



HELPFUL HINTS FOR VISITORS...

Purchasing rubbish bags

Rubbish and recycling bags can be purchased at the Hanmer Log Cabin, the Hanmer Springs Service Centre and Hanmer Springs Super Liquor. The Log Cabin's opening hours are Sunday - Thursday: 7am – 9pm and Friday - Saturday: 7am – 9.30pm. Hanmer Springs Service Centre is open 7 days 7.30am – 6pm and Hanmer Springs Super Liquor is open Sunday to Thursday 10am – 7pm and Friday to Saturday 10am-8pm.

Household glass bottles

In Hanmer Springs, household glass bottles are collected providing that: An official Hurunui Council glass recycling box is used, boxes do not contain other recycling or rubbish, boxes can be lifted safely, are not overloaded and are left at the kerbside of the property and all lids are removed. Glass bottles are crushed and used in road construction, so must be contaminant free.

Collection day

Weekly kerbside collection is on Mondays. These days change on public holidays and can be found on the Council website, just scan the QR code below.

Non-complying rubbish bags

Our contractor is authorised to sticker and leave them. Further information is printed on the bags.

Dos and don'ts

Make sure your HDC rubbish bag is under 15kg, securely tied, and doesn't contain anything that could endanger staff or damage the vehicle. This includes animal waste, sharp objects and medical/ hazardous waste.

Transfer Station hours

Out of hours recycling for paper, card, cans, plastic bottles 1,2 and 5, and glass bottles are provided. Lids and soft plastics of any type are not accepted.

Only these items can go into your kerbside Recycling Bag!



PAPER & CARDBOARD

All items must be empty, clean and loose in the recycling bag.






FOOD, DRINK & PET FOOD CANS



PLASTICS



Plastic bottles and containers:

-  **Soft drink bottles** (no lids)
-  **Milk bottles** (no lids)
-  **Larger yoghurt and ice cream containers** (no lids)

If there's no number, throw it out.

NO

These items do NOT go into your kerbside Recycling Bag!

- ✗ Plastics numbered: 
- ✗ Soft plastics - i.e. any plastics that can be scrunched in your hand
- ✗ Plastic shopping bags and strapping
- ✗ Tetrapaks
- ✗ Glass bottles
- ✗ Polystyrene and polystyrene meat trays
- ✗ Clothing and shoes
- ✗ Food or garden waste

GLASS BOTTLES

Glass bottles and jars (with lids removed) can be recycled via all transfer stations.
