DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Donaldson Family Limited for renewal of an Off-Licence in respect of premises situated at 255 Stockgrove Road, Amberley - Glasnevin, known as "Pegasus Bay Winery".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Donaldson Family Limited has held the on and off-licences for Pegasus Bay Winery for a year. New licences were required in 2018 when it was confirmed the company, not the licensee at the time, Dr I Donaldson, banked the funds from the sale of alcohol at the winery. Pegasus Bay winery has held licences since 1993.

The winery operates a restaurant and cellar door. The dining area is a class 3 restaurant as all service of alcohol is by table service.

The off licence is undesignated.


The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 16 March 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
