**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Aroha New Zealand Wines Limited for renewal of an On-Licence in respect of premises situated at 409 Omihi Road, Omihi, known as "Waipara Springs".

No changes to the conditions of the licence have been sought by the applicant.

Aroha New Zealand Wines Limited was incorporated on 14 July 2017. The applicant seeks to renew the on and off-licences to trade as Waipara Springs winery.

The applicant has traded since 1 December 2017, initially under temporary authorities and subsequently with on and off-licences.

Katherine Lumber is the sole director and shareholder of Aroha New Zealand Wines Limited. She has been an employee at Waipara Springs winery for four to five years with her duties including marketing, organising festivals, and overseeing the day to day management and operation of the café/restaurant.

The applicant was provided with an 'On-licensed premises toolkit' when the new applications were lodged in January 2018. Katherine has integrated and tailored this resource into the existing in-house systems and staff training. In particular, it is used to record manager's details including the appointment of acting and temporary managers.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions until 12 March 2022, that being three years from the first anniversary of the licence.

Due to a practice direction from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority we authorise the issue of a replacement licence with a new number and notice of renewal.
