DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Sherwood Estate Wines Limited for an off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Church Road, Glenmark and known as Glenmark Domain

The nature of the particular event for which the licence is sought is a stall at the North Canterbury Wine and Food Festival with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Sunday 10 March 2019 from 10.30am to 4.30pm. The licensed area is undesignated and includes the stall.

A separate overarching on-site special licence will be held by Brown Bread Limited for all sales of alcohol to be consumed at the venue.

All staff will check the purchaser is wearing the appropriate wristband prior to making the sale.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

The District Licensing Committee agree to impose conditions on this licence to:

- Require the stall duty manager, or an experienced representative, to attend the pre-event on-site briefing, and
- To conduct a briefing for the stall staff on the information provided at the briefing and the stall licence conditions.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
