DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Hawarden A&P Association for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at Allandale Road, Hawarden and known as Hawarden Domain.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Hawarden A&P Show with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 20 March 2021 from 10.30am to 7.30pm. The licensed area includes the following areas:

An Undesignated licensed area:

Community Area

- A community barbecue and event area is an outdoor fenced area adjacent to the Lions Club bar area;
- A mechanical bull and other entertainment will be sited within this licensed area.

Various Supervised licensed areas:

Lions Ringside Bar

- The boundaries will be defined as the side and back of the marquee, the show ring fence rail and wire gates installed as fencing from the show ring fence to the marquee.
- There will be a single entrance to the bar area with a security person monitoring people coming and going from the bar area.

Presidents Tent bar

- The President's Bar tent will be located adjacent to the show ring rail and the boundaries defined through the use of rustic gates and straw bales.
- There will be one entrance/exit to this licensed area.

PGG Wrightson sheep tent

- The area is to provide morning tea and lunch to Stewards and Judges for the sheep section.
- Two sides of the PGG tent will form part of the site boundary. The fence to the sheep pens will form another boundary. The remaining site boundaries will be defined by lines painted on the ground.

Trade space exhibitors

- The trade stall licensed areas will not be fenced with the site boundaries defined by lines painted on the ground. The stallholders will be required to keep their patrons within their site boundaries. No alcohol can be taken from these trade stall areas.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event.

The licence may issue immediately.
