DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Glenmark Rugby Football Club for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 11 Reeces Road, Omihi and known as Glenmark Rugby Club.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is a Club Day with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 11 May 2024 from 3.00pm to 12Midnight. The licensed area is 'undesignated', meaning that persons of any age may be present. The licensed areas are the interior of the main hall and meeting room, and the paved area adjacent to the north and west of the hall.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

One of the designated duty managers for the event, Nicole Hurinui, does not hold a current manager's certificate. We are satisfied that the licensee will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence, therefore we grant an exemption from the requirements of section 213(1) to appoint a manager.

The licence may issue immediately.
