DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application by Copper Beech New Zealand Limited for an on-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The nature of the event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer Springs Fete 2024 with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 02 November 2024 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

The licensed area is undesignated and is defined as “the Chisholm Ward and Nurses Hostel areas of the Queen Mary Hospital site. The area will be fenced with temporary and existing permanent fencing and clearly defined as the Hanmer Springs Fete venue.”

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an off- site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this occasion or event (or series of occasions or events) for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
