### **DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application by Aroha New Zealand Wines Limited, trading as Waipara Springs, for an on-site and off-site special licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Jacks Pass Road, Hanmer Springs and known as Queen Mary Grounds.

The event for which the licence is sought is Hanmer Springs Fete with the days and hours authorised for the sale of alcohol being Saturday 02 November 2024 from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

The licensed area is undesignated and includes a one-metre-wide area immediately in front of the Left Branch Cider stall. The event organiser, Copper Beech New Zealand Limited, holds an overarching on-site special licence No. 57/SP/2415/2024, which allows customers to move freely around the venue with their alcohol.

In their reports, the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and District Licensing Inspector have raised no matters in opposition to this application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s. 142 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-site special licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol, to any person attending this event. We also grant the applicant an off-site special licence authorising the sale of alcohol, to any person attending this event for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licence may issue immediately.
